NEGATIVE THOUGHTS & EMOTIONS MAKE US SICK...

We were created for love and relationship as outlined in the two commandments Jesus left us (Matthew 22:37-40). In our relationships with God, within and with others, God wants us to experience peace, which is the absence of unresolved conflict.

Proverbs 14:30

A calm and undisturbed mind and heart are the life and health of the body, but envy, jealousy, and wrath are like rottenness of the bones.

Unresolved conflicts in our relationships with God, within or with others can erode our peace, and set us up for "dis-ease." Have you ever gotten upset with yourself or someone only to find yourself not feeling well both emotionally and physically?

Conflict in relationships can break our hearts. If we do not have our identity in God's unconditional love **and** don't quickly forgive, we lose our peace. It is not long

before "dis-ease" (a lack of cellular peace) appears. We can have headaches, trouble sleeping, digestion and elimination problems, depression, and many other symptoms that lead us to seek medical care that does not eliminate the cause of "why" we are physically ill and emotionally tormented.

Matthew 18:34 is clear that when we do not forgive, we are thrown over to the tormentors who steal our peace. If we forgive others like we have been forgiven, we can take back our peace. One of the believer's inherited blessings in the Kingdom of God is peace. Resting in our Heavenly Dad's love and care as His adored sons and daughters is the only true place of lasting peace in a world gone mad!

Many people have never heard their earthly father's say, "**I love you!**" It is very difficult for them to trust and believe Heavenly Dad could be any different.

There are many brokenhearted people including Christians who have yet to truly forgive from their hearts because they are still looking to imperfect people, accomplishments and things to give them significance. Our love, approval, significance and identity come from the heart of a Father Who was willing to give up His only Son to die for our sins so that we could be adopted by a Father Who **perfectly** loves us and gives us peace.

If we are still thinking and speaking about offenses, then

we have not truly forgiven from our heart. We will be tormented spirit, soul and body.

I thought I had forgiven people who had abused me emotionally, verbally, physically, financially, sexually and even spiritually, but I was still keeping a record of wrongs done to me. I would go to the elders for prayer and the anointing with oil, but I only grew sicker and sicker.

After many years of being too sick to minister, collecting SSDI benefits, and having a full time caregiver, the doctors said I was dying. I had seen everything from cancer to bee stings healed, so I knew it wasn't unbelief or a lack of faith that was keeping me sick. The only other possible explanation I could come up with was that God was angry with me. I didn't have my identity as Heavenly Dad's adored daughter even though I was a minister and had gone to Bible College.

Beloved

I wish above all things that you may prosper and be in health, even as your soul prospers.

I began an in-depth study of medical and psychological research that **supports scriptural truths** as they relate to spirit, soul, and body.

Many scriptures confirm the research in fear stress physiology and provided answers that led to my healing from environmental illness, multiple chemical sensitivities, chronic fatigue syndrome, asthma, fibromyalgia, depression, insomnia, seizures, panic attacks, rheumatoid arthritis, irritable

bowel syndrome, allergies, post traumatic stress disorder, migraines, systemic candida, and adrenal gland failure.

I no longer have these diagnoses. I have peace and joy. I take no medications! Today I **know** God is **not** angry with me, and I'm **not** upset with myself or anyone on the planet...**I'm at peace in a world gone mad!!!**

I have been working with brokenhearted believers for 22 years. Jesus said it would be impossible for offenses not to come. One of the reasons He died was for our healing. Complete and lasting healing cannot come when we are in relational conflict and experience emotions long term like shame, guilt, fear, self-hatred, anger and bitterness.

People receive phone ministry from all over the US and Australia to learn more about how negative thoughts and emotions make them sick. I have learned first hand the power of forgiveness and repentance (changing the way I think about God, myself and others, my past, present and future) as the only way for the body and soul to prosper.

Jesus has healed phone ministry recipients of: Fibromyalgia, Alzheimer's Disease, Obsessive-Compulsive Disorder, Asthma, Allergies, Insomnia, Psoriasis, High Blood Pressure, Neck & Back Pain, Depression, Heart Arrhythmias & Fibrillations, Migraines, Hypoglycemia, MS, Myasthenia Gravis, Bi-Polar, Schizophrenia and others!

throughout the world. Both were licensed and ordained in 1989, by Dr. John E. Douglas, founder of the American Evangelistic Association. Dr. Marjorie Douglas, widow of Dr. Douglas and an AEA member of the Board of Elders, brought greetings on behalf of the Association.

Refuge of Hope operates faith-based community outreach centers, founded upon biblical principles, through educational, spiritual, social, and recreational programs for youth and adults. STREET CHILDREN OF IRAN

Dear Church Family and Friends,

As many of you might know, over the past years the Lord has put a great passion in our hearts to reach the people of Iran with the Gospel of Jesus Christ and to encourage and strengthen the persecuted church in Iran. We have been privileged to participate in spreading the gospel of Jesus Christ to thousands of Muslims inside Iran and to see many of those come to Christ and hundreds of underground house churches starting in more than 30 cities in Iran where there had never been churches.

Due to several arrests and court hearings over the last few years and specially the recent (August 2009) arrest and Court hearing that Saeed had, AND in order to be able to continue serving the Lord inside of Iran without endangering the underground churches, we have been seeking the Lord for a new direction over the last year.

As we have sought the Lord and sought to know His Heart and Passion, we have felt a great burden and passion for a different group of people on the streets of Iran. They are the street children of Iran.

According to the Iranian government's own admission there were at least 60,000 street kids in 1995. Numerous child rights organizations suspect that the number is substantially higher, citing figures of 200,000 or more. In Tehran alone there are between 35,000 and 50,000. These children live in abandoned buildings, containers, automobiles, or on the street. Not surprisingly, the mortality rate of these children is very high. It is reported that from 100 to 150 children die each month from malnutrition, unsanitary conditions, and criminal activities. Many of these children are forced to work as prostitutes, others simply disappear.

As we have cried out to the Lord for a chance to help these vulnerable children and to lead them to the knowledge of Jesus Christ, the Lord has been opening up pretty amazing doors and confirming this passion in our hearts.

We have felt a great burden and passion for a different group of people on the streets of Iran. They are the street children of Iran.

- 1) There is a land that has become available to purchase for the orphanage at a very good price that we had initially thought would not become available.
- 2) Many of these street kids are mutilated and owned by certain groups that use these kids to make money. Taking away these kids from these gangs/groups in itself has seemed impossible and something that we have been praying about in addition to getting permission to own orphanages as Christians in Iran. The Lord again confirmed that this is indeed the direction He wants us to go by providing us a resource that is willing to help us and has been named by the United Nations as a key person helping orphans and street. We have a good relationship with this person and this relationship will be invaluable in helping us get the necessary documents and approval from the government to get the orphanage started as well as to utilize the experience this person has to get the kids out of these gangs that continue to mutilate and abuse them.

Saeed is going to Iran at the end of June to purchase the land for the orphanage and begin setting up the orphanage. This orphanage will enable us to get children off the streets and provide them with education and family, with the goal of leading the children to Christ.



We hope as you prayerfully consider this opportunity to make a difference for the kingdom of God by giving these precious little ones a safe place to grow and learn about Him, and that you would partner with us in prayer. Please pray that God would continue to lead in bold and miraculous ways. Pray that the Holy Spirit would greatly equip us, and prepare the hearts of those in authority so the orphanage can be opened without delay. Please pray that He would provide all the resources we need, both physically and financially.

Please pray for Saeed's safety as he heads back to Iran as the danger of being arrested is always a threat.

BE SURE YOUR MINISTRY IS IRS COMPLIANT

Attention: AEA Member Affiliates

Since May 2010, the IRS Requires organizations that have failed to file an annual 990-series return or notice for three consecutive years will automatically lose their tax-exempt status.

Tax-exempt organizations, **other than churches or church-related organizations, MUST FILE** a FORM 990, 990-EZ, 990-N (ePostcard) or 990-PF (for private foundations) with the IRS. Unless you have an IRS granted classification letter indicating you are a church, or if you do not qualify as an operating church, you must file the 990.

Any **active** subordinate organizations that are **not** included in the annual return filed by AEA, or have not sent us up-to-date required paperwork and annual renewal payment, will not be covered by AEA's Group exemption.

IRS uses the following attributes to define a Church, by court decision, and generally a combination of these characteristics. They include: distinct legal existence; Recognized creed and form of worship; definite and distinct ecclesiastical government; formal code of doctrine and discipline; distinct religious history; membership not associated with any other church or denomination; organization of ordained ministers; ordained ministers selected after completing prescribed courses of study; literature of its own; established places of worship; regular congregations; regular religious services; Sunday schools for the religious instruction of the young; schools for the preparation of its ministers
