60 YEARS 1954-2014 The Beginning and Founder of AEA

Greetings In the Name of Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ

Dear Brother and Sister Members and Friends:

The American Evangelistic Association has for 60 years' served God's called men and women in all areas of Ministry. Our desire for every servant in the Lords vineyard to be all they can be for the glory of God, always enlarging their ministry vision to cover more territory with the un-compromising word of God's holy word. Isaiah 54:2 tells us "enlarge the place of thy tent and let them stretch forth the curtains of thine habitations: spare not, lengthen thy cords, and strengthen thy stakes."

Let me tell you a little bit about the founder of AEA, Dr. John E. Douglas, Jr. Dr. Douglas had a track record of service in the Lords vineyard starting at a very early age. Traveling with his mother and father in Evangelistic Ministry, he would clean if need be and making sure the church was warm in the winter. He learned to read starting at the age of three. He wanted to read the Bible. Like father, like son, he spoke before congregations by the time he was five. The Lord had his hand on him, never to let him go. He loved and served the Lord in good times and hard times. Dr. Douglas pastored many years wherever the Lord would send him. God blessed him with a winning personality, the gift to communicate to impart God's truth with understanding, and the exceptional gift to counsel with wisdom.

Dr. Douglas had a deep sorrow in his heart for the men and women with a calling to ministry in bondage to a Ecclesiastical system. A system more of man than God. Dr. Douglas took it

before the Lord to settle his many questions. God answered and AEA was born.

The Autonomy of the local assembly, under the headship of Christ, led by and directed by the Holy Spirit. The Pastor is the star that is held in God's hand. He does not see in Revelation the church as a candelabra, but seven separate golden candlesticks, He has epitomized it in the following statement; "The headship of Christ, the leadership of the Holy Spirit, and the fellowship of believers".

God had a man, the heart of a man under Gods calling and leadership, the independent move spread like wild fire across the land when the Holy Spirit was given his rightful place in the hearts and lives of Gods' people in his office to prepare a glorious church without spot or blemish for our Lord.

Dr. Douglas was called and forerunner of this movement, serving in a tireless motion to show Gods men and women they are free in the Holy Spirit to preach the Good News.

Let's bond together in strength and unity to be a voice to be heard and strength to be reckoned with.


