### Letter of Update -

### BETHANY MINISTRIES, ORISSA, INDIA

#### Praise Report -

***I will call open the Lord who is worthy to be praised. Psalm 18:3***

We thank God and praise God for the wonderful guidance and help of our Lord and saviour Jesus Christ during the month of May & June 2016. God did miracles among the people. Our living God did great things and enabled us to visit 181 villages to preach the word of God in the most unreached evangelized areas. We thank God for the opportunity to make contact with nearly 3219 people and we distributed 1026 gospel tracts and 1020 New Testament Bible to the people.

We thank God for His guidance to preach among with tribal people in the villages of Terapali, Muniguda, Sikir and in Ambadula among the Hindu people.

We thank God for the nine new people who are now born again and took water baptism and have been added to our Bethany local churches in various fields. Church services are conducted regularly and there has been revival by attending church services, according to the monthly work reports from the various fields of our Bethany Missionaries.



In the village of Borgoan, five families, 35 people, were totally rejected from the village and community. They were not able to bring the water from the public bore-well and pond. The Hindu people are very strong there, but I thank God these believers faith in Christ is strong. Their prayers, asking and requesting for a bore-well in their own land was heard, and God provided! Now, they are greatly enjoying having their own bore-well in their

own land. They believed God to provided this miracle.

We distributed 9 Holy bibles in the month of May and June to those who wanted water baptism. Many have testified at Sunday service that they have been blessed by reading the Holy Bible and that more people need to have Bibles.

We thank God that through the Audio Film Ministry, we had the opportunity to meet and contact unreached people and we showed the film to 7 villages. People came to know that Jesus is the God of the world.

By the grace of God and His guidance, all of our Bethany Co-workers are doing hard labor in order to bring perishing souls to Christ. We thank God, through prayer of our Missionaries.

People are being healed from various kinds of diseases. God is using myself and my wife miraculously in the fields. People come 100 KM to our house for prayer

and stay at our home for three or four days for prayer. My wife Padmini Senapati, prays for them and people are healed, and testify it was God who healed them before their congregation.

Pray for our Evangelism and Church-planting ministry in the state of Orissa and Chhattisgarh (India) and supply gospel literature among the unreached people.

Our field co-workers are in need of daily jobs. Most of the workers are not getting any support from any side. Bethany still needs sponsors to help support all the missionaries, gospel workers and disciple makers. Sometimes they sleep without food, their families daily needs and their children are living without education. They want to do labor work, but sometimes it is very difficulties to find any work. But, I thank God in this situation also, the Co-workers are doing hard labor to win the perishing souls to Christ.

Pray and become a supporter of the Bethany Orphan, poor, needy and destitute children. We have started an English Middle School this year and want to give free education to those who are needy.

We need 1000 Holy Bibles to distribute to the believers of Bethany Church in the tribal area.

Pray and support to build 3 Church buildings in the Bethany Missionaries fields.

Pray to God for the power of Holy Spirit to do miraculous work in our church through myself and my wife Padmini Senapati.

# AEA & CBCS Special Relationship

The American Evangelistic Association (AEA) was founded, in 1954, by Dr. John E. Douglas and Dr. Marjorie Douglas, in Baltimore Maryland, as an organizing and covering body for independent Christian Ministers and their Churches. For nearly sixty-three years now, AEA and her members have faithfully served the Kingdom.

The Chesapeake Bible College & Seminary, (CBCS) which began its ministry in 1977, under the leadership of Dr. William Comfort and Dr. Shirley Comfort, also in the Baltimore area, set itself out to provide top quality Biblical College education at prices that would bring the cost of higher education from the top shelf to within reach for all that would desire to learn. And so, for nearly forty years now, CBCS has faithfully served the Kingdom.

Perhaps that is why it has been in God's plan to see the two organizations who share similar purpose and values align with each other. AEA to fulfill the role of covering and assisting Ministers and Ministries in their work, while CBCS works to educate those who are called to the Service. In 2013, the two organizations formed an agreement where AEA would recognize the education credentials provided by the Chesapeake Bible College and Seminary, for those who sought Membership in the AEA, and that AEA would recommend CBCS as a very worthy institution for Biblical studies.

Melbourne Florida's AEA Affiliated Ministry Community Gospel Truth Church, under the leadership of Bishop Jerry Lawrence & Co-Pastor Maria Lawrence, are participating in the online development effort.

In addition, AEA Board Members are closely involved in the guidance and development of this effort, ensuring that the caliber of the school's educational excellence remains at top levels.
