AEA Evangelist Alan Greene Extending an Invitation to AEA Members

AEA member and Evangelist Alan Greene recently spoke at the 68th Annual AEA Regional Conference in Melbourne, Florida. He is the Co-Founder of LifeLight Communications, a proclamation evangelistic ministry based in Sioux Falls, SD which is now in its 25th year.

Alan also serves on the council of GNE (Global Network of Evangelists) a worldwide network of evangelists started by the Luis Palau Association.

The Global Network of Evangelists seeks to Identify, Affirm, Equip, and Mobilize evangelists around the world. GNE also provides resources and training to help in advancing the Gospel in most any context.

Alan says, "Being part of GNE has allowed us to network and collaborate in a way never before accomplished" Our recent trip to Thailand was a perfect example of collaboration which glorified God and utilized the gifts of each participant."



Thailand is less than 1% Christian, so to say they were excited at the opportunity to preach the Gospel would be an understatement!

The three-day festival in Thailand followed a two-day pastors conference where Alan and his son-in-law Josh Brewer had the honor to speak along with other GNE evangelists.

It was an incredible week of sharing the Gospel through American and International musicians, power lifters, dancers, evangelist, pastors, and speakers. The festival in Chiang Mai drew thousands of people and they saw over 600 commitments to follow Jesus!!

One evangelist or pastor can only do so much, but when linked together the financial

investment goes further and there is a greater impact in the community served.

Thailand is just one example of many, where partnering and collaborating with the focus on



the proclamation of the Gospel is happening. Just in the last couple of months, events have taken place in Pakistan, Kenya, South Africa, and the US. There are many pastors, missionaries, and followers of Jesus who have the call and gifting of the evangelist and we believe we are better together as we seek to see the fulfillment of Matthew 24:14 around the Gospel in various events.

"And this Gospel of the kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come. "

We would like to extend an invitation to the AEA members to consider applying and joining the GNE network.

Many of you who are part of AEA are serving in hard places around the world and you are not alone. We encourage you to stand strong and persist in the advancement of the Gospel.

Dr. Marjorie Douglas, who served alongside Dr. John Douglas, founder of the American Evangelistic Association, as his loving caregiver, dedicated wife and friend, also was so passionate and inspiring concerning things of the Lord to everyone she met and especially among the pastors she shepherded in the AEA.

Rereading the AEA's tribute to Dr. John Douglas, much of the same wording truly applies to Dr. Marge Douglas, because her goals and aims were always to Advance the Gospel Message and to cause the Kingdom of Heaven to grow on the earth. Read these words concerning Dr. John Douglas, as published in an early edition of the "AEA Spotlight" newsletter and, if you had the privilege of knowing Dr. Marge, we can agree this absolute truth regarding her as well:

"Hundreds of issues concerning church disputes were settled because [s] he was there for the pastor. Every AEA pastor knew they had a listening ear with their leader. [S]he revived the pastors who were "burned out." [S]He lifted the downtrodden and [s]he forgave and restored the fallen. All his life Dr. [Marge] John has been the rare combination of a visionary, evangelist, leader, and friend. When [s]he knew he was right, nobody had more focus than [Dr. Marge] John Douglas and all those who were out of accord stepped aside. When people said it couldn't be done, Dr. [Marge] John encouraged them to move forward. When the many said there was no money, Dr. [Marge] John knew the Lord was waiting to provide it. When the gloom and doomers talked about giving up, Dr. [Marge] John ran up the flag."

Dr. Marge always took the time with those she connected with to encourage and motivate them in the things of the Lord as exemplified through her Spirit of Love towards all she met - saved and unsaved. She was a great guiding light providing a beacon to focus the efforts of the AEA Board of Elders on those matters which perpetuated and expanded the Kingdom of God.

We miss her here on earth, but so glad to know that we will be together for all time - and we can hear her now cheering us on, as we do great works for the Kingdom through Christ who strengthens us, as she peers over the banister of Heaven. Thank you, Dr. Marge - we so appreciate all you have done - setting us a brilliant example to follow - in your Life well Lived here on this earth.
